***LATE REGISTRATION:** A \$100 late registration fee will apply to all registrations after June 1st. A \$150 late registration fee will apply after June 15. Please visit our office to begin payments as soon as possible. These late fees also apply to initial payments on fee adjustments and approved payment plans.

***SESSION CHANGES:** Please be mindful that we pay for many trips and programs in advance and many are non-refundable. There is a \$200 session change fee after June 15 and a \$250 session change fee after camp begins.

***ALL REQUESTS FOR CHANGES MUST BE IN WRITING.**

Camp Fee Includes

Fee Adjustments

Fee Adjustments are available for those who qualify but are limited and on a first come-first serve basis, so please apply early. Discounts can't be combined. To apply, please call: 718.792.1800 ext. 0. We accept approved 1199, TWU, ACD and other union registrations (**ACD not accepted for Teen Camp.**)

Early Drop-Off and Late Stay Programs

Early drop-off begins at 7:00am. Late stay campers must be picked up by 6:30pm. There is a \$20 surcharge per half hour for late stay and non-late stay campers that are picked up late.

Transportation

Pick up and drop off at a designated community location is available for an additional charge of \$100 for full summer, \$50 for one session. Please see page 10 for bus schedules.

Additional Important Information

CAMP DEPOSIT: One half of the total camp fee is required at registration and the balance is due by May 1, 2023. **Payment received after this date is subject to a \$50 late fee. After May 15, late fee is \$100.**

SIBLING DISCOUNT: For full session enrollments, deduct \$200 per sibling; \$100 per sibling for half session. The discount does not apply to the first child or families receiving fee adjustments. Cannot be combined with other discounts.

REFUND POLICY: There is no service charge through February. There is a \$100 service charge for cancellations in March and a \$200 service charge for cancellations in April. Sorry, but there are no refunds after May 1.

SUMMER SCHOOL REFUND: For those children who may be left back and are mandated by their school to attend Summer School, a full refund (less a \$200 administrative charge) will be issued upon verification by a school letter along with a written request from the parent. This does not apply to enrichment or Summer Rising programs. Requests must be submitted in writing to the Camp Director prior to the 1st day of camp.

MEDICAL REFUND: Refunds for children being withdrawn from camp due to injuries that prohibit them from attending will be considered pending a current relevant doctor's note along with a written request from the parent and will be subject to the refund policy in effect at the current time (if granted).
